Day 2 Wednesday, June 9

Lucerne

07:25AM: Welcome to Switzerland! Upon arrival at the airport meet your tour escort and driver and travel to the city centre of Lucerne, where you will enjoy a **guided walking tour**. (Zurich – Lucerne, approx. 1 hour drive) The tour features the wine market, the wooden bridge and the Löwendenkmal (Lion Memorial), which is dedicated to the Swiss guards who died defending Louis XVI in 1792. Welcome dinner and overnight in Lucerne.

Day 3, Thursday, June 10 Performance #1

Lucerne

After breakfast, take a **1-hr cruise** across the lake, enjoy this beautiful lake and the spectacular views of the Swiss Alps. Afternoon for exploring the city of Lucerne including magnificent shops, galleries and cafés. **Afternoon / evening performance** for example in the Jesuitenkirche or the Hofkirche. Enjoy group dinner this evening featuring traditional **Swiss cheese fondue** at a local restaurant.

Day 4, Friday, June 11

Lucerne – Munich

Travel on to Salzburg, Austria today, *World-famous musicians like Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, Richard Wagner and Carl Orff lived in this beautiful region where they found their inspiration and creativity*. **En route you will** visit the Neuschwanstein castle, the home of Mad King Ludwig of Bavaria. This is one of the most beautiful castles in Europe. Walt Disney certainly thought so, as he fashioned his famous Cinderella castle at Disneyland after Neuschwanstein. Arrive in Salzburg in time for dinner and check in at our hotel.

Day 5, Saturday, June 12

Salzburg

Day 6, Sunday, June 13

Salzburg --Munich

This morning there is a possibility that you will sing a morning church service in Salzburg, perhaps at the Kollengienkirche, or the famous Cathedral. Mid afternoon we will drive the beautiful route to Munich, stopping at Dachau WWII concentration camp. We will plan a memorable short concert there. This will be one of your most vivid memories. On to Munich for overnight.

Day 7, Monday, June 14

Munich

This morning we will have a guided tour of Munich, capital of the region of Bavaria. You will see the Olympic Stadium, the ultra modern FC Bayern Munich soccer stadium. Continue to the old town center

for a walking tour and see the treasures of the old town like the Gothic Frauenkirche church, the Marienplatz square, the Neues Rathaus with its famous carillon , the Residenz, former residence of the Bavarian kings and much more. Your will end your tour at the 200 years old Viktualienmarkt, the main local marketplace where locals buy their fresh food. Evening performance in the the Peterskirche or the St. Michael's Church followed by our farewell dinner and overnight in Munich.
